## A message from Mrs Spinks - Live for Lily

To the Macleod College community, parents, staff and students,

I just wanted to send you a brief note regarding the fundraiser Ms Tran and her brilliant leadership team are running this coming Friday, the Live for Lily colour run and sausage sizzle. I wanted to firstly, thank them and you, for supporting the Live for Lily charity. It has been a very tough year to organise events, and I am grateful for their perseverance in ensuring this event happens.

I would also like to take the opportunity to tell you a little more about Live for Lily. The foundation's namesake, Lily, was my niece. When she was 8 years old she was diagnosed with a rare and aggressive liver cancer. 13 months later after much chemo, radiation and 6 operations my niece died at the age of 9.

Following this, my brother set up the Live for Lily foundation dedicated solely to raising money for research, its aim being to find a cure for childhood cancer.

Since the foundations beginnings in 2016 it has raised just over 1 million dollars, all of these funds going directly into research. The foundation is run solely by volunteers, so every cent of money raised goes to this cause. One of their annual fundraising events is the Ride for Lily. I have completed this event twice already and next year shall do so again. The 2022 ride 'Bike to the Barossa' is 1100 km long over 7 days from Melbourne to the Barossa Valley in South Australia.

I have decided to complete next year's ride again in memory of my niece and also to support my brother and nephew who, at the age of 15 will also be riding. My aim is to raise as much money as I can for this cause. The training is long, tough and often not that enjoyable, but worth it to help find a cure for this horrible disease.
